

GUIDELINES FOR ETHICS

The Ethics Committee must review all written complaints received, and submit a full report to the Board of Directors within 60 days of receipt of said complaint. It is also responsible for all revisions of the Bylaws.

The Ethics Committee will deal with complaints concerning the alleged unprofessional conduct of its members to the general public, other dealers, or at shows, whether conducted by CSADA or others. Such conduct could consist of any type of improper behavior including willful violation of CSADA Bylaws.

When by-law changes need to be made, the Ethics Committee shall write the proposed by-law changes approved by the board for approval by the membership. Ethics shall then present the proposed by-law changes to the membership for discussion and vote.
